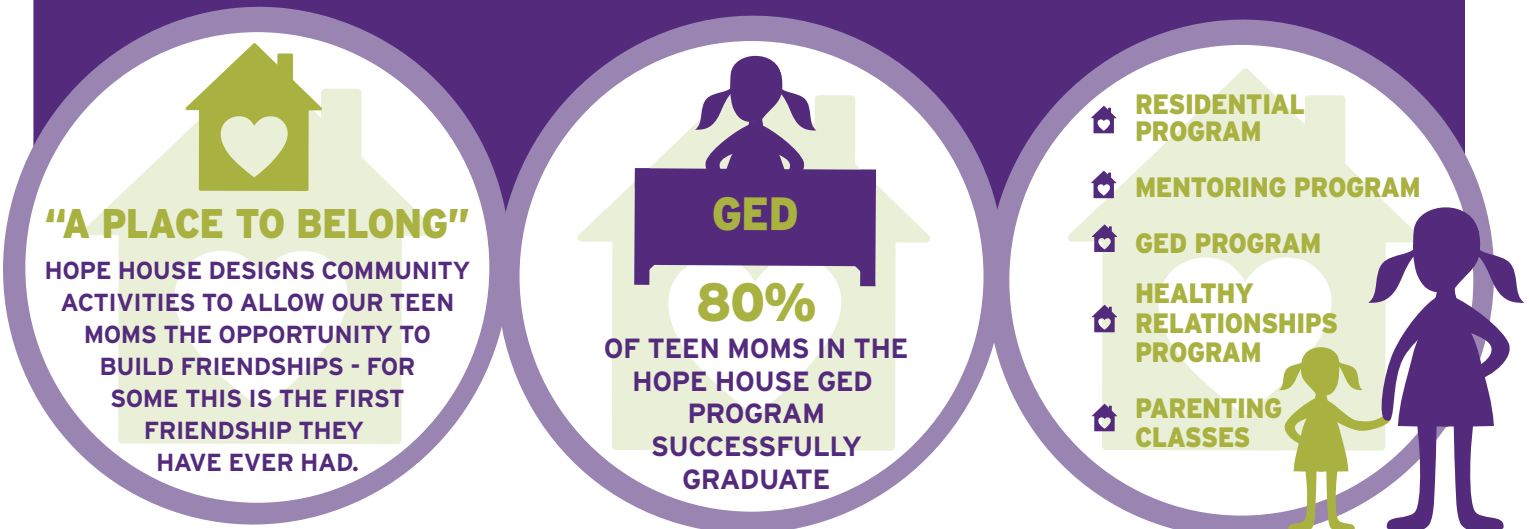


THE CHALLENGE: BREAKING THE CYCLE

Hope House of Colorado is metro-Denver's only resource providing parenting teen moms residential, mentoring and GED services, equipping them for long-term independence. Additional empowering services include parenting and life skills classes, healthy relationship classes, certified counseling, and social activities designed to promote community. Hope House serves approximately 110 girls and 160 children per year.
